Is situated on the waters of the Columbia river where it widens out and becomes the Lower Arrow Lake, on its west side, 15 miles below the north end, in the Dominion Electoral District of Yale-Kootenay and Provincial District North Riding of West Kootenay, it is 100 miles south of the C.P.R. at Revelstoke, and is connected with it by the C. & K. S. N. Co's steamers during the season of navigation, about eight months of the year; also with Nelson and Kootenay Lake, via steamers and C. & K. Ry, 50 miles south. Farming is the principal industry.

In the Dominion Electoral District of Vancouver and Provincial of Nanaimo; is situated southwest of the Esquimalt & Wellington railway, to which there is a siding for freight and the powder works. There is also a line to the colliery wharf on Departure Bay. The main road to Wellington passes through the hamlet. Northfield coal is the best worked by the New Vancouver Coal Co., and is their only shaft on the long wall plan. When trade is brisk some hundreds of hands earn their livelihood here. The mine is yet young and at places rocky, but behind, the seams are rich and thick.
