XXII.

CONFERRING DEGREES ON BRETHREN NOT MEMBERS.

Any brother not a member of this Lodge, may be passed or raised, for the sum of *twenty-five shillings, currency, for each degree*, provided that he has been made in a regular Lodge, and produces satisfactory proof to that effect.

XXIII.

VISITORS.

No visitor shall be admitted into this Lodge, unless he be personally known, satisfactorily vouched for, or after due examination by one of the Brethren present; and during his continuance therein, he shall be subject to its By-Laws.

XXIV.

BEHAVIOUR.

At the sound of the Master's Gavel profound silence shall be observed. Should any brother swear, or utter any irreligious or obscene language, offer to lay wagers, interrupt any Brother while addressing the Master, sit down unclothed, use irritating or insulting expressions, on masonic, or private subjects,
