FRENCH HOLD GROUND IN ARGONNE AGAINST HEAVY ATTACKS Big German Munitions Depot at Chauny Attacked by Airmen RUSSIANS READY TO REPEL INVASION OF BALTIC PROVINCES

KULTUR TO TRY FRESH PLAN ON EASTERN FRONT

LONDON, July 16. (10.30 p.m.)—The Austro-German armies, which now appear to be working in concert as the result of the German organization, are giving the Russians little rest or time to reorganize themselves after their retreat from Galicia.

LONDON, July 16. 8.45 p.m.—The day has brought no change in the South Wales coal strike situation. The wet weather, which kept the men indoors prevented the holding of the mass meetings which had been arranged, but a few gatherings took place in small halls where speakers devoted themselves to attacks on the colliery owners and the press, which is outspoken in condemnation of their action in quitting work.
