The City was then bounded — On the north by a stream and marsh, now marked by Craig Street, on the west by Fortification Lane and upper part of McGill Street of to-day; — on the east by the Place d'Armes station of to-day; — on the south by the little river St. Pierre and the St. Lawrence. — This plan of the fortifications was published in London by Thomas Jefferys, Geographer to his Royal Highness, the Prince of Wales, January 1758.
