

cers of the Provincial, Divisional or Subordinate Council or the member offending shall have been summoned to show cause to the Grand or Provincial or Divisional Council having jurisdiction, why such sentence should not be enforced; such summons being addressed and either delivered personally or sent by registered post to the last known place of residence of said officers or members being deemed a sufficient service.

INDECOROUS LANGUAGE.

17. When any memorial or other document shall be presented by any member of the Grand Council, either on behalf of himself or another, the member presenting it shall be responsible that such paper does not contain any improper matter, or any offensive or indecorous language.

18. ORDER OF AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF THE GRAND COUNCIL DURING THE TIME OF BUSINESS.
