## FARMERS AND DROVERS ADVISED ON SHIPMENTS

The following advice has been given  
dealers at the live stock market:

1. Farmers.—Use care in delivering  
stock to loading station.
2. Drovers.—Use care in loading at  
shipping point.
3. Report to your commission firm or  
stock yard management any trouble with  
loaders, pens or chutes—a remedy will  
result.
4. Don't beat animals with sticks.
5. See that there are no nails or pro-  
jections in pens.
6. Report to your commission firm or  
stock yard manager any abuse of your  
stock in unloading.
7. Telegraph your commission firm  
time stock is loaded, with car number,  
and report any delay in movement and  
cause thereof.
8. Bear in mind that losses thru  
bruised animals find their way back to  
the dealer.
9. Dehorn your cattle.
