*Time of going through the Falls.*

**T**HE Falls are level (or still water) about three hours and an half on the Flood, and about two hours and an half on the ebb, which makes it passable four times in 24 hours, about 10 or 15 minutes each time.—No other rule can be given, as much depends on the floods in the River St. John, and the time of high water or full sea, which is often hastened by winds, and in the proportion to the height of them.
