Nov. 17.—H. Pryor, Esq., D. C. L., was appointed a member of the W. &. O. Committee.

The Secretary was directed to publish a statement correcting the erroneous impression which had been conveyed by the refusal of the Block Sum.

DEC. 15.—The Bishop read a letter from the S. P. G., stating that the Society could not increase its grant to Nova Scotia, and that if the D. C. S. refused to receive the Block Sum, the S. P. G. must reduce the payments to the Missionaries within the proposed amount.

The Bishop stated that he had written to the S. P. G., suggesting a compromise, and was waiting an answer.

JAN. 19, 1872.—A legacy of \$1200 to the D. C. S., and \$400 to the Superannuation Fund, from the late Hon. M. B. Almon was announced.

The Bishop read a letter from the S. P. G., fixing the payments from the Block Sum for the year 1872, and offering a certain amount, provided the D. C. S. would be responsible for the deficiency:
