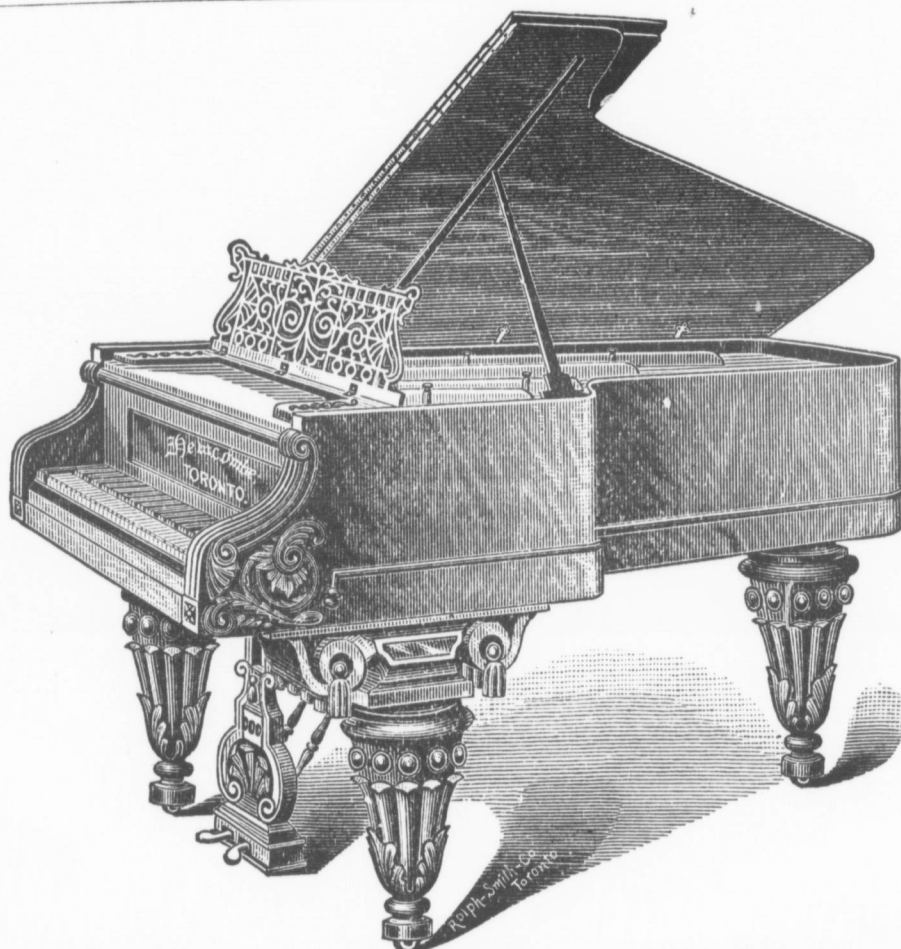




## "THE GEM OF THE EXHIBITION."
