THE MULTIPLYING AUTOMOBILE
(Ottawa Journal.)
There are over 3,000,000 automobiles and motor trucks in the United States. There are 600,000 in Canada. Yet it was scarcely twenty years ago that the gasoline engine for vehicles was invented. In these figures is wrapped up the story of human eagerness to move swiftly, and to appropriate whatever contributes to the pleasure or the saving of labor. The development of the automobile and its adaptation to the needs of life form a striking chapter in the progress of civilization.
New York state leads in the number of automobiles, with 339,221, just as Ontario takes first place in the Dominion. Ohio, Pennsylvania and Illinois come next in the order named. That California should rank fifth is no more surprising than the place which the pastoral states hold. Fifteen years ago, or even ten, the idea of the auto being taken up by the farmer, who was assumed to be wedded to his horses, as well as hopelessly conservative, would have been cast aside. Today the homely handed son of toll owns nearly half of all the automobiles in North America. During the past three years he has bought almost three automobiles for every one sold in the cities. This has been as true of Canada as of the United States.
Some people are disposed to see in the increasing use of automobiles a demonstration of the swelling tide of extravagance and pleasure-seeking which has been sweeping over prosperous America for years past; but there is another side to the matter. Pleasure undoubtedly has

something to do with it, yet utility is an important factor. The well-to-do young farmer is just as fond of his joyrides as is his city cousin, but it is not all joy-riding with him. He comes from the city one way and another, to making his auto pay for its keep. He has found many uses for it, and he is going to stick to it.

The auto is a big tax-payer. In the United States the cost of registration reached \$100,000,000 last year. Assuming that the scale of charges is the same on this side of the water, it will be seen that the provinces must have received something over \$7,000,000 from that source in 1920. The investment of that sum annually in better roads would, in course of time, show magnificent results.


