Then, later still though yet a boy, I read the stories of Bothwell Brig and of Claverhouse—I was perfectly impartial between cavalier and covenanter—and of John, duke of Argyle, who, when Queen Caroline told him she would make a hunting ground of Scotland, answered, "In that case, madam, I must go down and get my bounds ready!" and of the death of Montrose on the scaffold, who "dimbed the lofty ladder as 'twere the path to heaven."
