An Act to amend the Naturalization Laws of this Province.

HEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Naturalization Preamble.

Laws of this Province, and further to the control of the Province and further to the Province and Province Laws of this Province, and further to shorten the period of continued residence required by the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her 12 V., c. 197. Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act to repeal a certain Act therein men-5 tioned, and to make better provision for the Naturalization of Aliens;" Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enac as follows:

I. The Act cited in the preamble to this Act shall be so amended as Required term to reduce the term of continued residence required by the fourth section of residence reduced to thereof to three years or upwards, instead of seven years or upwards; three years. 10 and the words of the oath required to be taken under section five of the said Act, or in any certificate or other proceeding, shall be varied accordingly.

Il. The Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, 18 V., c. 6, chapter six, intituled "An Act to amend the Naturalization Laws of repealed. 15 this Province," shall be and is hereby repealed; Provided always, that Proviso. the repeal of the said Act shall not affect the naturalization of any person naturalized under it, or any right of any person acquired under and in virtue thereof, but all rights so acquired shall be possessed and enjoyed as if the said Act had not been repealed.
