if he shall fail so to give bond within ten days, then the contract shall be given to the next lowest bidder, who will give bond as aforesaid.

XI. Binding.

XIII. The binding of the Laws, Journals, and the volumes of the Public Documents, shall be in the same style, and of the same materials, as of the volume of Statutes of this present Session.

Accounts and Vouchers for Printers' work.

XIV. In counting the folding and stitching of all Bills, Resolutions, 30 Pamphlets or Documents, no half sheets shall be counted, charged for, or allowance made. Folding, stitching and binding shall include the collating, drying, and pressing, and no charge or allowance shall be made for collating, drying, and pressing.

XV. That each contractor for any branch of the Public Printing, shall 35 fiyle and preserve one copy of each document, or other matter by him printed for the Province, which fyle he shall deposit, together with his accounts for printing, with the Provincial Secretary, on or before the first Monday in , annually; in which account shall be specifically stated the various jobs performed, the number of ems composition in each, 40 the extra charge, if any, for rule and figure work in each, the number of tokens of press work in each, designating whether ordered by the Legislative Council, Legislative Assembly, or jointly by both, or by other officers or agents of the Province, together with the kind and quantity of paper used for each job. · 45

XVI. Each contractor for the folding, stitching, covering and binding, And for folding, stitching, shall fyle and preserve one copy of every document or other matter by him binding, &c. folded, stitcahed or bound, which fyle he shall deposit, together with his accounts for the same, with the Provincial Secretary, on or before the first day of , annually; which account shall specifically state each 50 item, as provided for in the twelfth Section of this Act, and the number of copies of each Bill, Resolution, Pamphlet or Document folded, stitched or
