## BILL.

An Act to incorporate a Company for making a Railroad from the Village of Industry to the Township of Rawdon in Lower Canada-

WHEREAS the construction of a Railroad from In- Preamble. dustry Village to the Village or Township of Rawdon would greatly contribute to promote the trade and facilitate the communication between the County of 5 Leinster and the adjacent Counties, and the Cities of Montreal and Quebec, and would tend much to advance the prosperity of all those portions of this Province; and whereas the several persons hereinafter named are desirous to make and maintain the said Railroad: Be it there-0 fore enacted &c.

'That Jedediah H Dorwin, John Jeffries, Philemon Dugar, Certain per-Alexander Daly, and Samuel Anderson, together with such rated. person or persons as shall, under the provisions of this Act, become subscribers to and proprietors of any share 15 or shares in the Railroad hereby authorized to be made and other works and property hereinafter mentioned, and their several and respective heirs, executors, administrators, curators and assigns, being proprietors of any such share or shares, are and shall be, and be united into a 20 Company for carrying on, making, completing and maintaining the said intended Railroad and other works, according to the rules, orders and directions hereinafter expressed, and shall for that purpose be one body politic and corporate by the name of " The Industry Village Corporate 25 and Rawdon Railroad Company" and by that name shall name. have perpetual succession and shall have a common seal,

not inconsistent with this Act, and by that name shall and may sue and be sued, and also shall and may have power 30 and authority to purchase and hold lands (which word Word Lands' shall throughout this Act be understood to include the land atood in this and all that is upon or below the surface thereof, and all Act the real rights and appurtenances thereunto belonging,) for them and their successors and assigns, for the use of
