accounted for.      4. In case of the appointment of the Company to any trust  
or office by any court in Canada, or judge, clerk or prothonotary  
thereof, such court or any judge thereof may, from time to  
time, require the Company to render an account of its adminis-  
tration of the particular trust or office to which it has been so 5  
Investigations appointed ; and may, from time to time, appoint a suitable  
person to investigate as to the security afforded to those by or  
Reports. for whom its engagements are held ; and such person shall  
report thereon to such court or judge, and the expenses of  
Costs. such investigation shall be borne as ordered by such court, 10  
judge, clerk or prothonotary.
