HEREAS an Act was passed in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, intituled, An Act for the better Prevention and Punishment of Attempts to feduce Perfons ferving in His Majesty's Forces by Sea or Land from their Duty and Allegiance to His Majesty, or to incite them to Mutiny or Disobedience, which was to continue in force until the Expiration of One Month after the Commencement of the then next Sellion of Parliament; and which faid Act was by feveral Acts further continued until the Expiration of Six Weeks. after the Commencement of the present Session of Parliament: And whereas an Act was made in the Thirty-eighth Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intituled, An 18th for empowering His Majesty for a Time, and to an Extent to be limited, to accept the Services of fuch Parts of His Militia Forces in this Kingdom, as may voluntarily offer themselves to be employed in Ireland, which was to continue in force until the Expiration of One Calendar Month after the Day of the Commencement of the then next Seffion of Parliament; and which faid Act was amended and further continued, by an Act made in the last Session of Parliament, intituled, An Act to continue, until the Expiration of One Month after the Commencement of the next Seffion of Parliament, an Act paffed in the laft Seffion of Parliament, Chapter Sixty-fix; videlicet, on the Twenty-first Day of June One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight, intituled, " An Act for · empowering His Majesty for a Time, and to an Extent to be limited, to accept " the Scrvices of fuch Parts of His Militia Forces in this Kingdom, as may vo-· luntarily offer themselves to be employed in Ireland,' until the Expiration of One Month after the Commencement of the prefent Seffion of Parliament : And whereas an Act was made in the Thirty-fifth Year of His pretent Majefty's Reign, intituled, An Act for rendering effectual His Majesty's Orders in Council of the Sixteenth and Twenty-first Days of January One thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, respecting the Admission of the Effects mentioned in the faid Orders, into the Ports of this Country to be warehoused; and for indemnifying all Perfous who have acted in consequence of fuch Orders: And whereas another Act was made in the Thirty-fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act to make further Provision respecting Ships and Effects come into this Kingdom, to take the Benefit of His Majesty's Orders in Council of the Sixteenth and Twenty first Days of January One thousand seven hundred and ninety-five ; and to provide for the Disposal of other Ships and Effects detained in or brought into the Ports of this Kingdom : And whereas another Act was made in the Thirty-fixth Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act to indemnify all Perfons who have acted in confequence of Orders in Council, iffued fince the Twenty-fecond Day of November One thousand seven hundred and ninetyfive, for the Admiffion of certain Articles of Merchandize in Neutral Ships, and to authorize the iffuing of Orders in Council for the like Purpose for a limited Time; which faid feveral Three last recited Acts were, by feveral Acts, further continued until Six Weeks after the Commencement of the present Session of Parliament: And whereas an Act was made in the Thirty-feventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act, authorizing His Majesty, for a limited Time, to make Regulations refpecting the Trade and Commerce to and from the Cape of Good Hope; which faid last recited Act was, by feveral Acts, continued until Six Weeks after the Commencement of the present Session of Parliament : And whereas an Act was made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His 3
