
Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your three letters of the 30th ultimo, inclosing copies of Resolutions passed by the Indians of Manitoulin Island requesting the Department to grant permission to certain members of the Band to cut and sell 300 cords of soft wood at Manitowaning, 250 cords of softwood for the Girls' School, 250 cords of softwood to the Missionaries at the village of Wikwemikong for the boys' school and 150 cords of softwood to William Wallace at South Bay mouth.

In reply I beg to inform you that permits may be issued for the same on the usual conditions.

Inclosed herewith you will receive the duplicate of agreement made between the Indians and Mr. Jas. Playfair, which has been duly signed and executed by the latter.
