- A. Yes, sir.
- Q.44 When you were in the vegetable room you didn't look for them again?
- A. No, sir.
- Q.45 Did you see them at any time later?
- A. Yes. I saw Gnr. Coll later when I returned to the kitchen.
- Q.46 Had he been there all the time?
- A. I couldn't say, sir.
- Q.47 Do you know which of the four of you is the senior man, Edr. Hughes, Daniels, yourself or Richmond?
- A. No, I couldn't say.
- Q.48 Did you know at the time, or did you say you didn't know, Lecompte was on duty?
- A. I didn't know.
- Q.49 Was Cpl. Richmond on duty?
- A. He is in charge of that kitchen.
- Q.50 When you were in the hallway outside the kitchen, I understand that the accused struck you in the face?
- A. Yes, sir.
- Q.51 Then you returned his blows?
- A. Yes, sir.
