OTTAWA, ONT.—Davidson & Thackray have decided to rebuild their planning mill on Rochester street west, between Maple and Wellington streets.—A special committee has recommended to council that a new fire engine be purchased.—F. Gourdeau, Deputy Minister of Marine and Fisheries, will receive tenders up to July 2nd for fairing and reinforcing plates, etc., for the steamer "Stanley."—St. George's Society have definitely decided to erect a new hall on Bank street.

ST. JOHN, N. B.—I. Manning, secretary School Board, wants tenders by 5 p. m. of 25th inst. for desks and seats for Dufferin school.—McKean & Dunn, architects, are asking for tenders up to June 30th for erection of MacDonald's Consolidated School at Kingston, N. B.—G. E. Fairweather, architect, is this week taking tenders for installation of heating and plumbing apparatus in new warehouse of T. H. Eastbrooks.—It is stated that F. E. Sayer & Co. have purchased land at Chipman on which to erect stores, etc.—The Canada Life Assurance Co. have purchased the Burpee building on Prince William street, which will be remodelled and fitted up as a modern office building.—The proposed new Y. M. C. A. building, towards which subscriptions are now being solicited, is expected to cost between \$60,000 and \$80,000.

MONTREAL, QUE.—The Road Committee will ask for a sufficient sum to replace with stone the wooden revetment wall on Sherbrooke street.—It has been decided to build three new fire stations, for which plans will be prepared by the following architects: No. 1 station, by Perrault & Lesage; No. 9 station, by W. E. Doran; St. Mary's East station, by R. Montbriand.—The council proposes to construct sewers on portions of Bover, Gilford and Cuvillier streets.—R. Mitchell & Co. have purchased 180,000 square feet of property in St. Henri on which to erect a large manufacturing establishment.—McGill College Y. M. C. A have

decided to take immediate steps to erect a new building of pressed brick and stone, at an approximate cost of \$50,000.—Ald. Chausse, architect, has prepared plans for extensive improvements to the east-end abattoir.—Building permits have been granted as follows: T. Latarelle, three storey building, cost \$3,800; Canada Paint Co., two-storey building, Hunter street, cost \$5,000; M. Butler, two-storey building, cost \$2,500; A. G.
