And the owner or consignee of the same articles, shall at the same time make and subscribe an affidavit (to be indorsed upon the said affidavit of the said master) before the said Treasurer or one of his Deputies, stating that he is the owner or consignee of such articles, and that the contents of such affidavit so made by the said master, are just and true, according to the best of his knowledge and belief.
