

An Act to revive, alter and continue, an Act, passed in the 39th year of his present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for raising a revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a duty on persons hereafter to be licenced, to keep public Houses or Shops for the retail of Spirituous Liquors, and for regulating such public Houses and Shops; also, the Act passed in the 40th year of his Majesty's reign, in amendment of the above recited Act; also, an Act passed in the 41st year of his Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act in addition to and in amendment of the above recited Act; and also the Act passed in the 46th year of his Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act in addition to and in amendment of the above recited Act.

After which Mr. Speaker spake as follows :

May it please your Excellency,

I BEG leave to present to Your Excellency, on behalf of the Commons of Nova-Scotia, a Bill for appropriating the Supplies granted the present Session for the support of His Majesty's Government, and the service of the Province for the ensuing year, and to request your Excellency's assent to the same.

His Excellency was pleased to give his assent to the said Bill following, viz :—

An Act for applying certain monies, therein mentioned, for the service of the ensuing year, and for appropriating such part of the Supplies granted in this present Session of the General Assembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province.

His Excellency was then pleased to make the following SPEECH :

Gentlemen of the Council and Assembly,

I EMBRACE, with great pleasure, this occasion to release you from the Public Service, to attend to your own private affairs; relying fully, that at all times, but more especially at a period of such peculiar importance as the present, you will, in your respective Districts, wisely cultivate that prevailing Spirit of Harmony and Loyalty, which I hope will long continue to render this a strong, respectable, and happy Province.

Afterwards the President of His Majesty's Council, by His Excellency's Command, said—
