## DOMINICK DALY, Lieutenant Governor.

WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands prorogued until Monday, the twentyfifth day of September, instant:

I have thought fit further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and the same is hereby further prorogued until Tuesday, the twenty-sixth day of September, instant—THEN TO MEET FOR THE DISPATCH OF BUSINESS—of which all persons concerned are required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

> Given under my hand and the great seal of this Island, at Charlottetown, this second day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, and in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign.
