BORDEN'S NAVAL POLICY.

No Canadian Navy But a Gift of \$35,000,000.

On Thursday last Premier Borden brought down his naval bill, which provides a gift to Great Britain of \$35,000,000 for the purpose of building three dreadnoughts. The ships are to be equipped and manned by England and to be part of the English fleet.

The newspapers throughout the English speaking world have commented on the bill, some in favor, others not in favor of it.

The Liberals at Ottawa are in favor of the Laurier policy, which was to build, equip and man the ships in Canada, forming a nucleus for a Canadian navy, to protect our own shores and to aid England in any time of necessity.

Sir Wilfred spoke on the Borden scheme on Tuesday.

The Toronto Globe says:

"Mr. Borden has dealt a deadly blow at the principles of a Canadian naval defence force. His policy is a policy of tribute. Forgotten are his fervent words of March, 1909, in favor of a Canadian navy; forgotten his expressions of national pride as he joined Mr. Foster in urging that Canadian manhood as well as Canadian money should be devoted to the safeguarding of the Empire at sea. Today he offers Britain the price of three 'Dreadnoughts,' but not a sailor to man them."

"If he means what he says, Canada is committed to the payment of a 'Dreadnought' tribute for a half-century, and Canadians are asked to assume a position of inferiority and to make confession that they are unable to undertake the organization of their own defence upon the high seas."
