Nfld. Veteran in Town. Richard Walsh of St. John's Nfld., arrived in town this morning from Montreal where he had been on business. Mr. Walsh is engaged with Mr. R. Hiley, both of whom are ex-sergeants of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, in the manufacture and fitting of artificial limbs at the general hospital in St. John's. Both men saw much service overseas, going first to Egypt, then being transferred to the Gallipoli peninsula, where they took part in that awful campaign against the Turks and in which thousands of brave men lost their lives. The two went through the various battles unhurt. Later they were sent to France and fought in the Somme offensive of 1916 where each lost a leg. The two went to Chicago after recovering from their wounds where they studied the art of artificial limb construction with the J. A. Rowley Co. On their return to St. John's they became attached to the general hospital, every one of which has given the greatest satisfaction to its wearer. —North Sydney Herald, June 13.
