MEMORANDUM OF CABINET MINISTERS REQUESTED.

At 10 p.m. yesterday the members of the United Fishermen's Committee, headed by Capt. Jesse Winsor, presented at Government House a petition of the undersigned fishermen, qualified electors of various places in this Colony, an Executive Committee appointed by public meeting, which the following petition presented:—

The Hon. W. F. Coaker, Minister of Marine and Fisheries, is Senior Member for Bonaville Bay, and as the representative of the House of Assembly in the House of Assembly, and as Minister he is officially in receipt of our most vital interests, we are all fishermen.

It has come to our knowledge that a long period he has been absent from his duties as Minister of Marine and Fisheries, either out of the Colony on official business, or at Port Union, or at the discharge of his duties as a commercial underwriter, during the whole of this period he has been in receipt of pay from the Government.

It is self-evident, Sir, that the duties of an office so important as that of the head of the Fisheries Department cannot faithfully and properly be performed by a Minister who is absent from his post; and the expenditure of public money on his salary is an indefensible waste of the public funds.

There is at present a crisis in the fishery business, and practical fishermen holders of fish licenses, in the endeavor to procure prices. Many unladen fish are lying in the harbor of St. John's. No deliveries of fish are made at fishing premises. Currencies are so low that great distress is sure to result unless an immediate place. Memorials have been presented to you, Sir, on this subject, and are being considered by the Government.

We have urgently appealed to the Hon. W. F. Coaker to resign his office, and he has emphatically refused to do so. We have, therefore, the honor to request you, Sir, our unanimous opinion that you should ask the Hon. W. F. Coaker to resign as Minister of Marine and Fisheries, and as a member of your Executive Council, that you should appoint in his stead, some fit person to perform the services for which he is paid.

We pray that you will be pleased to order accordingly.

Yours petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray.

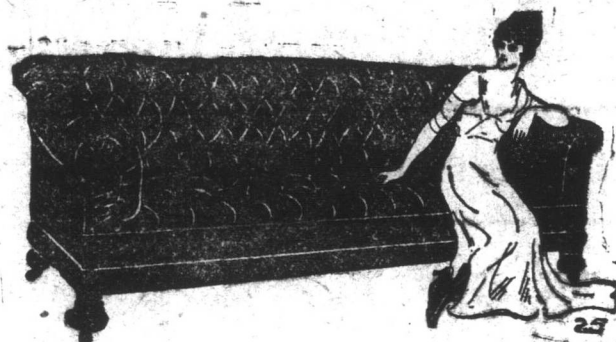

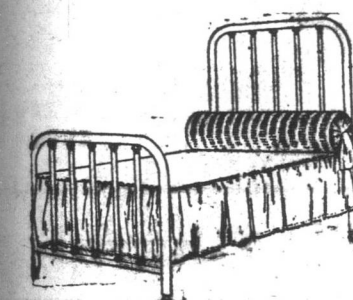
