

INCURABLE INSANITY TO BE PLEA OF HAINS

Mrs. Hains May Take the Stand
Against the Slayer of
Annis.

New York, April 18.—Insanity, not of the momentary and vanishing character usually invoked as a defense for emotional crimes, but permanent and incurable, will be urged, it is stated, as a defense in the case of Peter C. Hains, jun., whose trial for the murder of William E. Annis at the Bayview Yacht Club, last August, begins tomorrow at Flushing, Long Island.

John F. McIntyre, chief counsel for the defense, announced today that no recess would be had to the expert testimony of alienists.

The Hains lawyers contend that Capt. Hains' mental condition is such that he does not know that Annis is dead. There is a possibility, they say, that the prisoner's derangement is as palpable as the attorney's declaration that the trial may be halted, pending the appointment of a commission in lunacy, before which the prisoner is to be taken for examination.

District Attorney Dewitt, who will conduct the prosecution, believes that the prisoner is sane and always was in full possession of all his faculties.

He has intimated that Mrs. Hains, whose alleged infatuation for Annis was the indirect cause of the shooting, would take the stand as a witness for the prosecution.

BINGHAM OFFERED CANAL ZONE JOB

Has Accepted Taft's Tender, Says
Rumor—Dan Finn to Succeed Him.

Washington, April 18.—A report is current among Democratic politicians in this city that President Taft has offered a responsible executive position in connection with the Panama Canal construction to Gen. Theodore Bingham, now police commissioner in New York City.

Bingham, it was said, has accepted and had already given Mayor McClelland his resignation as police commissioner. The salary is said to be three times that enjoyed by Bingham in his present office.

It was also said that the name of Daniel Finn, a police magistrate in New York, has been mentioned as a successor to Bingham as commissioner of police in New York City. It was added that the selection of Judge Finn was due to the influence of Charles F. Murphy, and was the strongest indication yet given of the peace pact recently entered into between the mayor and Tammany Hall.

THE LEMIEUX ACT WILL BE INVOKED

Winnipeg Street Railway Employees Will Test Its
Efficiency.

Winnipeg, April 18.—The operating employees of the street railway have decided to invoke the Lemieux act in an effort to settle the difference with the company, other negotiations having failed.

The principal question on which the cleavage occurred was the recognition of the union. The men desired that the clause in their agreement with the company providing that there shall be no discrimination against any employee who is a member of the union, should be extended to include all employees of the company, even to the car barn cleaners. This was refused and an advance of one cent per hour for all men who had been in the employ of the company three years was rejected, pending the settlement of the other question.

The men will likely name Rev. Dr. Patrick, principal of Manitoba College, as their representative. The union profess confidence that the trouble will be amicably settled.

The wages the men are receiving at present are: For first six months, 21 cents per hour; for second six months, 22 cents; for second year 23 cents; after the second year 24 cents.

BODY FOUND IN TRUNK

Probably Remains of Spy Murdered
by Russian Revolutionaries.

Rome, April 18.—The discovery of the body of a young Russian in a trunk left in a garret of the Via Frattina has created the deepest excitement. The body lay undiscovered from Feb. 28 until this week.

It is considered certain that it is a case of vengeance by Russian revolutionaries on a traitor or a spy, but the suggestion that the corpse is that of an Azef, the notorious "revolutionary" agent of the Russian secret police, is discredited, since the life of that of a young man, while Azef was a middle-aged man.

An expert examination has established the fact that the victim was poisoned by prussic acid. The poison hindered the decomposition of the body, which was found to have no wounds of any kind.

The landlady states that on Feb. 25 a person of some 45 years of age hired the room. The lodger's name was Roscoe. On Feb. 24 he called at the boarding house in the Via Frattina, which is almost exclusively frequented by Germans. On the morning of Feb. 26 he sent for a trunk. Toward noon on the same day he was visited by two friends. On the evening of the following day he ordered a supper, consisting of ham, cheese and wine. At 8 o'clock he returned with a friend. The latter left shortly afterward to fetch another young man.

A 9 o'clock Romanoff agent went out with another young man, some 30 years of age, dark-haired, with a black moustache. The landlady declares that she did not notice that three arrived and only two left. On leaving Romanoff gave up the key of his room, saying that he was going to spend a few days with his friend at Fiumicino.

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SULTAN HAMID MAY ABDICATE

Beirut, April 18.—A terrible uprising has taken place at Adana, where one thousand persons are reported killed, and it is said the city has been practically destroyed by fire. Two American missionaries were killed in the mad street fighting.

All the other American missionaries are safe.

The British vice-consul, Major Daughtry Wyllie, is among the wounded. He was shot through the arm.

At Tarsus there was less loss of life. The Armenian quarter was destroyed. Four thousand refugees are housed in the American mission.

The need of relief is great, for shortly the fugitives will be on the verge of starvation.

Conditions in the Vilayet of Alexandretta are most serious. It is estimated that over 4,000 have fallen victims to the fanaticism of Moslem hordes along the coast, east of the Mediterranean, from Beirut to Erzerum, near the Russian coast, where for two days the anti-Christian riots have been accompanied by slaughter, arson and rapine.

Slaughter and Rapine.

Women are being outraged by the Moslem soldiers and being carried off into the mountains, while the helpless children of the Christians, mostly Armenians, are dying with their parents.

Inflamed by the belief that the uprising in Constantinople endangers their religion, the Moslems are committing the grossest atrocities against Christians and the sands are blotting up the blood of hundreds of innocents.

Adana, 30 miles from the sea coast, is the centre of the massacre. Hundreds of people have been butchered and half the city has been laid in ashes.

On both sides for 600 miles the towns have been burned down accompanied by bloodshed.

Turkish authorities are helpless, and although orders have come from Constantinople to proceed against the perpetrators of the massacres they have not been given the slightest attention.

The Armenians in Adana put up a feeble resistance and killed 150 of the Moslem attackers, but their number was wholly unable to cope with the blood-seeking mobs which swept down from the city.

Armenians Wiped Out.

An awful night followed the second day of the riots. The Moslems exacted fearful toll for the killing of their comrades. Today the entire Armenian section is devastated. The bar-barities practiced by the Moslems were the most revolting in their long reign of unspeakable crimes.

Added to the horrors of the Turkish excesses could be seen Turkish raiders in their wake and the details are shocking in the extreme.

According to the latest news from Adana, the missionaries do not dare to leave the mission house. They are suffering from lack of provisions and medicines, and have sent an appeal to the military authorities for protection.

A British warship is proceeding to Alexandretta, which is threatened by the Moslems.

Several Armenian farms in that neighborhood have been destroyed. Alarm is felt at Kharput because of serious depredations by the Kurds in the surrounding villages, although the town itself has not been the scene of any particular disorders.

Commenting on the fact that President Roosevelt has set aside 70,000 acres on the Pacific Coast as a refuge for birds, a German periodical exclaims: "And this in the land of the dollar hunters, while we in idealistic warm-hearted Germany have within the last 50 years completely exterminated several varieties of birds."

THREE PERISH FROM SKIFF

Gananoque, April 18.—Mr. and Mrs. R. Robins, and Jack Taylor, all of this town, were drowned from a skiff near Clayton, N. Y., nine miles from here, Saturday afternoon.

The party left Gananoque about 1 o'clock for a pleasure trip, and no word of any accident was heard until a message was received from Clayton about 5 o'clock.

A man who is working on the island said he heard some one calling for help and he hurried to the scene in a skiff. He saw two persons holding to the bottom of the skiff when he started, but when he looked again there was only one. When he was a few feet from the skiff Mr. Taylor released his hold of the boat and sank. He dropped an anchor, marking the spot, and summoned aid.

The bodies of Mrs. Robins and Taylor were found this afternoon, but that of Robins has not been recovered. Mr. and Mrs. Robins were 23 and 17 years old, and Jack Taylor 19 years.

A COAST DEFENCE FLEET CANADA'S PART IN THE NAVY

Hon. Mr. Graham Announces Government Plans in Regard to
Imperial Defence and Names Commission of Four
to Operate the Intercolonial Railway.

Montreal, April 18.—At a banquet tendered Saturday night to Dominion Ministers Graham and Brodeur, two important announcements were made, the first, that it was the intention of the Canadian Government to build coast defence vessels in connection with Imperial defence plans, and the second the make-up of the commission that will hereafter operate the Intercolonial Railway.

Naturally in view of the Dreadnought discussion which has spread over the whole of the Empire of late, a good deal of the talk was along the lines of naval defence.

Both ministers devoted much of their speeches to an outline of the policy to be followed by the Government in the matter. In their discussion both repudiated the idea either of building Dreadnoughts for the imperial navy or giving a cash contribution to Great Britain to aid in the construction of warships. Hon. Mr. Graham condemned this as starting on a superstructure before a foundation for a Canadian navy had been made, and foreshadowed that the work to be undertaken by the Canadian Government would be to build vessels for our coast defence and to continue the policy of home defence started when the Dominion undertook to garribose Halifax and Esquimaux.

Mr. Brodeur stated that as soon as the session of Parliament was over, he and Sir Frederick Borden would leave for London, where they would consult with the Imperial authorities as to what had better be done by Canada in the matter of naval defence.

Tug Scuttled and Sent to Bottom

Buffalo, N. Y., April 18.—The City of Erie, the first passenger boat to arrive this spring, docked this afternoon. She brought 100 passengers from Cleveland. A heavy detail of police patrolled the docks today. Some time during the night the tug tug Scudder, which has been used to transport non-union men to their boats, disappeared from her slip, and it is believed she was scuttled and sunk in the river. HEAR HON. MR. BECK**

Who Presents Interests of the
Tuberculosis Hospital—Paper
