HAY WAS HIGH TODAY FIFTEEN DOLLARS TON

Market Was Very Slow—Oats Again Advanced—High as \$1.72 Paid.

There was another small market this morning. There were only about fifteen loads of hay offered for sale, but these brought a good price. Several went as high as \$15.50, while some sold as low as \$14. The prevailing price was about \$15.

There was a very small supply of oats in the market and the demand was very brisk. The price still continues to advance, and today they sold from \$1.65 to \$1.72. There is such a steady demand and so little apparently with which to meet that demand that there is little likelihood that there will be any decrease in price.
