

churches is doing the churches themselves great injury, said Dr. Straton, adding:
"Think of women, whose influence is world-wide because of their wealth and position, sitting at a ring-side watching and applauding two practically naked men, pouncing and bruising each other and struggling in sweat and blood until one is beaten down by cruel cunning and the sheer weight of superior brute force. Try to imagine the old-fashioned Christian women—yes, try to imagine your mother, my friends—attending a prizefight. Why, our minds balk at the very thought. Near Fifth Avenue, the fight was held, and degenerated today and how pitiful these selfish, cynical social leaders are in comparison with the modest, gentle, unselfish women of the past."

Donohue leaped to seize the probationer's revolver, but Mahoney fired and Donohue fell. Daring around the side of the building, Mahoney fired a second shot at Connelly, who returned the fire. In the meantime Police-man Edward Friel climbed into the taxi and opened fire. Mahoney fired his crumpled up, still holding his revolver.

The crowd which had watched the battle from a distance closed in, and the detective and his assistant could be taken to the Harlem Hospital. Donohue's wound was found by Inspector Henry and Inspector Sweeney Mahoney said:
"I was coming out of the cabaret when they tried to hold me up and I began firing. I know nothing that happened after that until I came to my senses at 10 o'clock this morning."

He was received at the hospital shortly after 2 o'clock and had been unconscious most of the intervening hours until noon. Despite his wound, which are in his left hip, body, head and lung, it was thought last night that he may survive. He was a brakeman on the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railway, before he was admitted to the training school on Aug. 7 for the course of six months. This escapade will end his prospect of becoming a policeman. He is in the prison ward on a charge of felonious assault, which he will have to face in the event of recovery.

Donohue is not permitted to have a revolver. Where Mahoney got the weapon is a matter that is under investigation. They are also searching for the two "rookies" who were with him. Like other recruits Mahoney had been assigned to a station to get practical experience in police patrolling. On Saturday night he was sent from the West Forty-seventh man on post. At 10 o'clock he reported back to the station, his prescribed tour having ended, and was relieved from further duty. Donohue's condition was said last night to be very dangerous. He is the father of seven children and lives at 1227 St. Lawrence avenue, the Bronx. He has been a member of the department since 1914.
