I have the honor to refer to your letter of 21st March 1972 relating to investments in St. Vincent which would further the development of economic relations between St. Vincent and Canada and to the assistance of the investment by the Government of Canada through the Export Development Agency.

I have the honor to confirm that the arrangements proposed in your letter with respect to Canadian investment in St. Vincent are contained in your Note and that the approval of my Government has been obtained in respect of the proposed investment.

Authority to proceed to this Agreement has been obtained from the Government of St. Vincent by Her Majesty's Government of the United Kingdom. Subject to the condition that the United Kingdom Government should not be held liable for any loss or damage in respect of the investment in the event of the Agreement by the Government of St. Vincent.

I therefore agree to your proposal that Your Excellency's Memorandum shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments.
