

- FS - Resignation/Attrition of Women Conclusion: Retention is a major problem
- FS - Fact Sheet Purpose: To highlight situation.
- FS - Career Progression Study of those FS who were formerly AS Conclusion: Men had enjoyed better career progression than women.
- FS - Comparison of assignments with aspirations as shown on Appraisal Reports of FS who were formerly AS Purpose: To highlight coincidence or non-coincidence of assignments and aspirations, focus on training and assignments. Thus far, one woman has attended the SMDP; another has become the first woman Area Comptroller.
- FS - Examination of methods of acquiring FS expertise and ensuring a more representative distribution of women Result: Serious consideration is being given to the possibilities inherent in lateral entry and secondments.
- ADMIN SUPPORT CATEGORY (ASC)
- ASC - Trainees for the Specialist Officer Development Programme are now in place Performance of trainees is being monitored.
- ASC - FSE Concept Pilot Projects are in place at six posts overseas A Co-ordinator has been appointed at each post. Periodic reports on implementation are being submitted.
- CR - Career Progression Study Conclusion: While progression to CR-4 was comparable for men and women a gap began to appear at the 5 level, with women progressing more slowly from 5 to 6 and 6 to 7.
