by the Secretary-General of UNCTAD, current proposals of buffer stocks, for indexation, and other relevant proposals, including the proposal for a general agreement on commodities.

- ii. measures which the international community can introduce for assisting developing countries -
  - (a) to increase food production;
  - (b) to promote rural development;
  - (c) to promote economic co-operation among themselves at the sub-regional, intraregional and inter-regional levels; and
  - (d) a review of existing organisations for industrial co-operation and development.
    - (e) to obtain greater control over, and benefits from, such activities as shipping, insurance, banking and other parts of the infrastructure for international trade and development.
- new and expanded forms of industrial co-operation,
  the enlargement of employment opportunities in
  developing countries, and more favourable access
  to the markets of developed countries;
