- 9:15 a.m. - The party leaves to visit the Royal Canadian Mounted Police establishment at Rockcliffe.
- 10:30 a.m. - The party leaves Rockcliffe to be received by the Charge d'Affaires of Haiti at his residence (112 Onslow Crescent).
- 10:50 a.m. - Arrival at 112 Onslow Crescent.
- 11:30 a.m. - Departure from 112 Onslow Crescent.
- 11:40 a.m. - Arrival at the Ice Palace at Lansdowne Park for a short visit before proceeding to the start of the Dog Derby at 12 noon.
- 12:15 p.m. - Departure for the War Memorial.
- 12:30 p.m. - The President lays a wreath at the War Memorial.
- 12:35 p.m. - Departure for the Chateau Laurier. (Entry - main entrance.)
- 12:50 p.m. - His Excellency the Governor-General arrives at Chateau Laurier. (Private entrance.)
- 1:00 p.m. - Luncheon given by the President of Haiti at the Chateau Laurier (ordinary dress).
- 4:00 p.m. - Reception by the Speaker of the House of Commons and Madame Rene Beaudoin. (Main entrance of the Parliament Buildings.)
- 4:45 p.m. - Leaves Parliament Buildings for Government House.
- 5:15 p.m. - Departure from Government House for Uplands Airport.
- 5:45 p.m. - Departure from commercial side of Uplands Airport.
- 7:15 p.m. - Arrival at Ancienne Lorette airport, Quebec City. Official welcome. The President and Madame Magloire and members of the party will stay at the Chateau Frontenac.

Friday, February 11 - Quebec City

- 10:30 a.m. - Departure from the Chateau Frontenac for the Parliament Building where the President and Madame Magloire will be received by the Legislative Council.
- 10:55 a.m. - The Presidential party will arrive at the Parliament Buildings and will be tendered an official reception by the Premier, Honourable Maurice Duplessis, and his Cabinet and their wives in the Legislative Council Chamber.  
The President will address the Legislative Assembly. From the Parliament Building the party will proceed to a reception at the City Hall by His Worship the Mayor, Honourable Wilfrid Hamel, and will sign the Book.
- 12:00 noon - Press conference at the Chateau Frontenac.
- 12:45 p.m. - The President adjourns to a room at the Chateau Frontenac to greet members of the local community.
- 1:00 p.m. - Luncheon offered by the Provincial Government at the Chateau Frontenac. Those not included in the luncheon will be entertained by the Haitian Charge d'Affaires.
