Mr. Woodsworth, seconded by Mr. Irvine, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 5, An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Blasphemous libels), which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The House then resumed the adjourned debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Ilsley for an Address to His Excellency the Governor General, in answer to his Speech at the opening of the Session.

And the Debate continuing, the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. Mackenzie King (Prince Albert), adjourned.

The House then adjourned at six o'clock, p.m.
