PRAYERS.

Mr. Trudeau, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table, —Copies of Agenda for the December Constitutional Conference. (English and French). Sessional Paper No. 5/1.

The following bills from the Senate were read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House:

Bill S-4, An Act to amend the Yukon Placer Mining Act.—*Mr. Chrétien*.

Bill S-5, An Act to amend the Oil and Gas Production and Conservation Act.—*Mr. Chrétien*.

The House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Benson, seconded by Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale),—That Bill C-7, An Act to authorize the provision of moneys to meet certain capital expenditures of the Canadian National Railways System and Air Canada for the period from the 1st day of January, 1969, to the 30th day of June, 1970, and to authorize the guarantee by Her Majesty of certain securities to be issued by the Canadian National Railway Company and certain debentures to be issued by Air Canada, be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications.
