

Positions held by graduates.

Graduates of the Department are to be found occupying positions of the highest responsibility in all parts of Canada, and in many other countries. In the engineering departments of the Government service, and of our railroads; in the construction of our great canals, harbours, and hydro-electric plants; in all kinds of structural work, whether in steel or reinforced concrete, and in many other fields of engineering work, distinguished service has been and is being rendered by men who have passed through our course. Positions requiring the exercise of great executive ability combined with technical knowledge are held in all branches of engineering activity. In university work, high distinction has been gained, as the chairs of civil engineering at Dalhousie, Winnipeg, Edmonton and Vancouver have all been occupied by our graduates. No attempt will be made to list the names of graduates in high positions, but personal knowledge of a large number of individual careers enables us to claim for the Department a large share of credit in the development of the Dominion, through the creation of its vast transportation systems, and the utilization of its natural resources.
