CANADIAN INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS (MONTREAL BRANCH) Programme for the Season 1932-33 PRIVATE: TO MEMBERS July 22. 1932. The Committee of the Branch have been giving careful consideration to the programme for the Branch's activities for the season commencing September 1932. In the light of the experience and developments of the last few years, the Committee proposes that the Montreal Branch's programme should be carried out during the forth-coming year through three different forms of activity, as follows:-A. A series of meetings to be held during the season September 1932 -April 1933 on the general subject of "Issues raised by the Imperial Economic Conference", these discussions to be led by either well informed members of the Branch or guests specially obtained for the purpose. The aim would be to produce eventually some report summarizing the discussions held. As many members of the Branch will have been following the proceedings of the Conference very closely or will have been in personal touch with members of one or other of the delegations, it is believed that the Branch should be particularly well equipped to carry on this proposed series of discussions. General meetings to be held from time to time during the year to B. hear distinguished visitors and experts discuss subjects such as those suggested in the list at the end of this notice. It is proposed that at these general meetings members of the Branch should be accorded the privilege of bringing to the meeting a strictly limited number of guests, subject to approval in advance by the Committee and provided that such guests are accompanied at the meeting by the member under whose auspices they have have been introduced. C. A number of small study groups (consisting of duly qualified members with in some cases the temporary addition of specially qualified non-members) will be organized to conduct original research and to prepare and present reports on certain subjects which may be considered as of particular importance and as best lending
