And, proud as we justly are of our country, and of its glorious defenders, let us all be careful that our pride does not rife into prefumption, nor our confidence into felf-fufficiency. Of ourfelves, les us think soberly, and as we ought to think. At all times graceful, Humility is at no period so graceful, as in the hour of triumph. And above all, it becomes us to cherish it, when we can not but be fenfible, that our prosperity has infinitely exceeded our defert.

Oppressed with the weight of the benefits which He has showered down upon us, with what sentiments of unseigned gratitude and devotion, should we now turn to our Almighty Benefactor! how earnestly should we endeavour, by faithful adherence, by chearful obedience, by enlightened zeal, by reverential love,
