FROM THE

RULES AND REGULATIONS.

The Reference and Circulating Libraries shall be open every week-day from 9 a.m. to 9.00 p.m., except Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Dominion Day, any day appointed by Government or Civic Proclamation as a Public Holiday, and such other days as the Board of Management may direct for the closing of the whole or any portion of the Library.

No person shall be admitted in an intoxicated, disorderly or uncleanly condition. No audible conversation will be permitted, and no person will be allowed to smoke, partake of refreshments, spit, ramble about the room, or bring any dog into the building.

No person shall be allowed to pass within the enclosure, or take any books from the shelves.

No person under the age of 14 shall be admitted to the reading room or reference library.

Any resident of Toronto shall be entitled to borrow books on signing the application, and upon obtaining the signature of one rate-payer (who must be approved of by the chief librarian or the Secretary) to the following guarantee * * * * or upon depositing the sum of three dollars with the librarian.

Each borrower, on payment of five cents, shall be supplied with a ticket, inscribed with his or her name, address and register number, which must be renewed at the expiration of the time mentioned thereon. This ticket must be presented whenever a book is borrowed or renewed, and, if lost, will not be replaced until thirty days after written notice of the loss has been given, except upon sufficient consideration by the librarian.
