

United Counties, are hereby authorized and required on behalf of this Council to attend to the execution of said bonds, which bonds after being properly executed and duly attested, shall be deposited with the Clerk of this Council, and his certificate of such deposit, shall be the County Treasurer's warrant for paying to any sub-treasurer the amount of School money in the County Treasury, and payable for the benefit of the Schools of the Township to which such sub-treasurer belongs.

X.—BY-LAW

TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF RATES.

1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Municipal Council of the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville duly assembled at the Town of Brockville on the twelfth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and it is hereby ordained and enacted, that if any person whose name is inserted upon the assessment Roll of any Township in the said Counties, shall neglect or refuse to pay the sum or rate for which he or she stands rated thereon, for the space of fourteen days after demand duly made of the same by the Collector of such Township, or his Agent duly appointed, the said Collector, upon oath before any one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said United Counties, of such demand and refusal or neglect of payment, as aforesaid, shall be entitled to demand an execution for the amount of rate or rates, which execution the said Justice is hereby authorized to grant; and upon receipt of the same the said Collector shall, and he is hereby authorized and required to levy the same, by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the person so neglecting or refusing to pay, giving eight days previous notice of such sale in three public places in the Township, and render the overplus (if any there be) to the owner thereof, after deducting the amount of the rates assessed, and the legal charges of the distress and sale.

2. That the Collector or Constable to whom such execution may be directed, authorized to be issued as aforesaid, shall be entitled to the following fees and no more for executing such execution, namely; four pence per mile for every mile he may have to travel to execute the same, which travel shall be verified upon oath, if required; and for levying, advertising, selling, and making returns, two shillings and six pence.
