MORNING NEWS OVER THE WIRES

The anniversary of the closing of the gates of Derry, which was celebrated by King James II. was observed in Fredericton yesterday by the "Pretence Boys" of that city. St. John's, 100 going up from here. The celebration took the form of a decoration day, the graves of the dead being decorated with flowers and flags. The celebration was held in the cemetery. New York, Aug. 13.—Ten minutes after his first assignment to duty at the Long Island Railroad crossing at Woodhaven, Queens, a flagman, Anthony Rispoli, of Brooklyn, was struck by a west-bound express train and killed instantly. He had stepped out of the way of an east-bound local directly into the path of the express before the motorman could apply the emergency brakes.
