Thug Methods In Paris Politics

Youths Beat and Otherwise Abuse Deputies—Even Attack Wife of One.

Paris, June 1.—Thug methods were introduced in Paris last night by a band of glided youths, adherents of Leon Daudet, a Royalist deputy. The band known as the "King's Peddlers," ambushed Deputy Marc Sangnier, a Socialist, gave him a beating and tried to pour tar on his head and administer a dose of castor oil. M. Sangnier managed to escape more or less damaged.

Another "peddler" waylaid former Minister of Subsistence Maurice Viollette and drenched him and his wife with ink. The "peddler" was arrested. A third youth administered a beating to the Socialist Deputy Marius Moutet. He also was locked up.
