GOOD NEWS FROM KINGS The announcement that Dr. G. N. Pearson has consented to permit his name to go before the Liberal convention at Hampton next week will be hailed with satisfaction by Liberals throughout the province.

WHO WILL LEAD Mr. John T. Hawke of Moncton, in a recent address in this city referred to the social unrest in all countries, and asked whether the Christian church would give direction to the movement, which will affect great social changes, or whether the leadership would be left to those Socialists who are antagonistic to the Christian religion.

THE SANITARIUM The Standard this morning says: "There will be no sanitarium for consumptives built in St. John this year. Although the council some time ago adopted a motion to establish a tuberculosis sanitarium and referred the matter to a committee, the necessary legislation to proceed with the matter was not secured at the recent session of the legislature, and no provision was made in the county estimates for funds."

CARING FOR CHILDREN The city of St. John may learn something from Winnipeg in the matter of taking care of neglected children. Canada Monthly for May contains a very interesting article telling in a general way what is done in the western city to look after those children who are not cared for by their parents.

There is in the first place a Children's Aid Society, which was incorporated under the Children's Protective Act to investigate cases of neglected, abused, dependent or orphan children. The society is empowered, if circumstances warrant, to become the legal guardian of such children and find them foster homes or otherwise suitably place them.

There is also a Children's Home in Winnipeg, and on the day on which it was visited by the writer of the article in Canada Monthly there were 190 inmates. This home was opened in a small way twenty-six years ago, but now it is well equipped and the public school board provides and maintains a building in which the children of the home attend school.

There is also in Winnipeg the Knowles Home for Boys. Mr. W. A. Knowles once took a little boy off the streets to his boarding-house because there did not seem anything else to do. This led to the establishment of the home and he had in its last fall forty-nine boys, working, ward or homeless. Some gathered there because their parents were dead, or the lads were beyond control and were sent there by the judge of the juvenile court.

There is also in Winnipeg the Free Kindergarten and the Children's Hospital and Free Dispensary for poor children, for which \$10,000 was raised last fall to erect a new building. There is also a Home for the Friendless, conducted by a Christian lady, where there may be found about 100 children and fifty to sixty-five women. The Margaret Scott Nursing Mission in one year paid 5,227 visits to infants and children, and it plans to develop children's work more along preventive and educative lines.
