

MOTHER OF FIVE HELD FOR MURDER

New York Police Say She Killed Man Who Refused to Marry Her.

New York, July 6.—Mrs. Louise Arnold, mother of five children, was arrested late yesterday on a charge of murdering Vincent Calveco, a watchman, whose body was found slashed with a bread knife, in the detention room of the children's court building yesterday morning. The police say she has confessed to the slaying.

Mrs. Arnold admitted, the police declared, that she had been infatuated with Calveco for several years. She is a widow. They say she wanted Calveco to divorce his wife, who lived in Lodi, N. J., and marry her. She visited him at the children's court building on Tuesday night, according to the alleged confession, taking the bread knife with her in a paper bag. When he again refused her request to marry her, the police quoted her as saying, she unwrapped the weapon and stabbed him in the leg, the blade severing an artery.

Survived Father Only Four Days

Captain Samson One of Four Brothers With Fine War Records.

London, June 14.—(By Mail).—Mr. Charles Leopold Samson, the well-known solicitor, died last Friday, and his eldest son, Captain W. L. Samson, P. C., died on Tuesday, the day of his father's funeral.

Mr. C. L. Samson, senior partner in Messrs. Grundy, Kershaw, Samson, and Co., London and Manchester, was born in Manchester in 1853. He was a Society's pianist and Stephen's gold medalist, and was admitted a solicitor in 1874. After serving a period of the Manchester Law Society, he was successively vice-president (1911-12), and president (1912-13), of the Incorporated Law Society, and was a member of the Council till his death. Mr. Samson was concerned with many important financial enterprises, especially with the Manchester Ship Canal in its inception and construction. He wrote a treatise on the

FOUR DECREES OF DIVORCE GRANTED

Fredericton, July 5.—Four decrees of divorce were ordered today to issue by Mr. Justice Crockett, of the New Brunswick court of divorce and matrimonial causes. The decrees were ordered in the following cases: George E. Logan vs. Rebecca Logan, the plaintiff residing in Fredericton and the defendant in Devon; Anna E. Bell Steeves vs. Frank Joseph Steeves, an Albert county case; Charles Kelshaw vs. Ethelred Kelshaw, also an Albert county case, and Stella May Mills vs. Harry Weedon Mills, a Moncton case.

The Logan and Steeves cases were unfinished from the last term. The Kelshaw case was a remnant, and the Mills case was the first new case heard. The third case unfinished at the last term, Stairs vs. Stairs, is taken into consideration.

Thomas Kenneth Raymond vs. Kathryn Christina Raymond, a St. John case, was extended in order to permit the defendant wife to file a reply. Another St. John case, Isabel

Brannen vs. Thomas Abner Brannen, filed for this sitting, was not entered.

Hearing was refused in the Albert county case of Martilla M. Babinéau vs. Joseph Babinéau, the court not being satisfied with the service of citation.

In Gordon Robert Steeves vs. Mary Regina Steeves, a St. John case, the allegation was that the defendant wife was unfaithful, and was now living in St. John with another man as his wife. Rev. A. A. Corbett, pastor of the George street Baptist church, testified

that the late Rev. T. A. Blackadar, who married the two, was an ordained minister of the Baptist church. The case was unfinished when court rose this evening.

HOMING PIGEONS' FATE

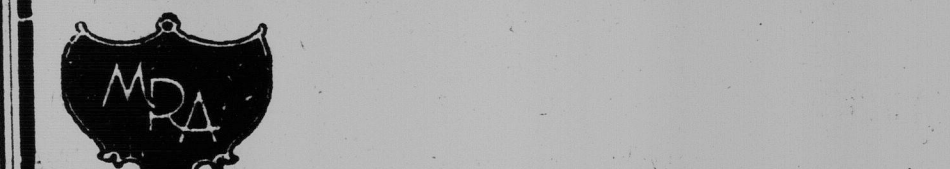
