has the first claim upon us all; and we have the best authority-even that of the Master Himself-for believing that personal consecration to His service, and active christian work, as the result of such consecration will result both in the higher spiritual life of the Church and in a better filled Treasury.

With grateful acknowledgments to Him whose blessing alone maketh rich, this Association earnestly prays that large numbers may be added to its ranks during the coming year, and that all its members may be found "steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord."
