- Q.15 By whom? By the Assistant Adjutant, Lieut. R. D. Grant. A.15 Who was? 0.16 At that time officer having custody of the original records. A.16 And from where did you procure this document? Q.17 From the records of A.27 Canadian Recce. Training Centre. A.17 And in particular from? Q.18 From the documents in my custody. A.18 Documents of the accused? Q.19 Respecting the accused. A.19 Is the trooper mentioned in this declaration the accused? Q.20 He is. A.20 The Prosecutor tenders the document as an exhibit. M.F.B. 375 is read and marked Exhibit "H", signed by the President and attached to the proceedings. I show you a second document. Will you tell the Court what it is? Q.21 A certificate of apprehension by civil authorities, by the R.C.M.P. Detachment at Roblin, Manitoba, respecting H.616559 Tpr. Chernesky, Edward, whom I identify as the accused (indicating the accused). A.21 By whom does this document purport to be signed? Q.22 By Cpl. W. A. Gill of the R.C.M.Police, in charge Roblin A. 22 Detachment. And from where was this document procured? Q.23 From the signer. From Cpl. Gill in the first place, A.23 and from my records. And in particular from whose documents? Q.24 The documents with respect to the accused. A. 24 The Prosecutor tenders the document as an exhibit. The Certificate of Apprehension is read and marked Exhibit "I", signed by the President and attached to the proceedings.
 - Q.25 I show you a third document. Will you tell the Court what it is?
 - A.25 M.F.B. 1481, being a certificate of costs of transportation only amounting to \$3.42, respecting H.616559 Pte. Chernesky, Edward, whom I identify as the accused (indicating the accused).
