When on active service, conduct  
to the prejudice of good order  
and military discipline -

in that he

Whilst stationed in the field, at about  
0320 hrs on the 21st of May 1942, was  
improperly in possession of one Thomson  
Sub Machine Gun No. 8274609 and 120 rounds  
of .45 ammunition, one .38 pistol and 5  
rounds of .38 ammunition, the same being  
government property on charge to "C" Squadron  
- 6 Armoured Regiment (1H).

*Second Charge

When on active service, conduct  
to the prejudice of good order  
and military discipline -

in that he

Whilst stationed in the field, at about 0325  
hrs on the 21st of May, 1942, after approach-  
ing the vehicle picquet, A.474 Tpr. McKenzie  
D.G. and A.102 Tpr. Pardaens A.A., as a friend,  
forced them at the point of a gun to throw down  
their arms and forced A.474 Tpr. McKenzie, D.G.,  
to accompany him in Vehicle No. CL 4215679, which  
he did improperly take, the same being govern-  
ment property on charge to "C" Squadron, 6 Arm-  
oured Regiment (1H).

*Third Charge

Absenting himself without leave -

in that he

Whilst stationed in the field, absented himself  
without leave from about 0330 hrs on the 21st  
of May, 1942, until apprehended by the Civilian  
Police about 0445 hrs on the 21st of May, 1942,  
a period of about one hour and fifteen minutes.
