

**OPERATING IN EAST KOOTENAY.**

Col. W. M. Ridpath and F. P. Hogan will leave Tuesday for a three weeks' trip through the Fort Steele mining district. They will go to Jennings on the front northern, and will there take the steamer for their destination, 150 miles to the Kootenay.

Col. Ridpath is president and general manager of the Sullivan Group Mining Company, which owns the Hope, the Star and the Shook. This company has made up chiefly of the principal owners of the Le Roi, and Col. Ridpath is going to the mines to set a force of men working developing the properties. Joe Palmer, former superintendent of the Le Roi, will go with him to superintend the work.

"We shall begin immediately the work of building two and a half miles of wagon road, to connect our mine with the north Star road, at the foot of North mountain," said Col. Ridpath yesterday. "At this point a townsite has been laid out. We shall also push work on the necessary buildings at the mine, and begin sinking our shafts early in the year. We shall employ about ten men, and will push development rapidly as possible. After a month's work we can determine the kind of material to be used, and indications lead us to believe that we have a great property in these claims. The surface showing is the most remarkable I have ever seen. We have enormous ore bodies right on the surface, and carrying high values."—Spokesman-Review.

## EDHAM PASHA IN HOT PURSUIT

**The Victorious Turkish Army Drives Demoralized Greeks from Point to Point.**

**Prince Constantine and Remnant of His Army Now Outrushed at Domokos.**

**Splendid Conduct of the Turkish Troops—Latest News from the Front.**

Athens, May 7.—Sir Ellis Ashmead-Bartlett, whose schooner was detained by the Greek fleet on the assumption that the papers found aboard of her were of a compromising character, arrived here last night. He was met at Rues by M. Ralli, the premier, who conducted him to the British legation and requested Mr. Egerton, the British minister, not to allow him to leave the legation before quitting Athens in order to prevent a demonstration.

It has been decided to send Col. Vassos to Thessaly, and Col. Stratou to the general staff will replace Col. Manos in Epirus; Major Constandes will be sent to Domokos.

Two transport vessels have been sent to Volo to remove the few remaining inhabitants. The ammunition stores and food supplies have already been taken to Styfus. It is rumored that a few wounded Greek soldiers left of Pharsalos have been captured by Turks.

Constantinople, May 7.—Edhem Pasha, the Turkish commander-in-chief in Thessaly, has sent the following dispatch to the ministry, dated Thursday morning: "The imperial army while marching on Pharsalos met the enemy in the villages of Soubathi, Souladji, Turcomanni and Lania. After an engagement lasting three hours we dislodged them from their positions and advanced to Pharsalos, which the imperial army has just victoriously occupied."

Berlin, May 7.—An interview with Count Bismarck, the German officer who reorganized the Turkish army, and who entered Larissa at the head of the Turkish troops, is published here. Bismarck dwells upon the splendid conduct of the Turkish troops, and says the capture of Larissa did not cost them a single man. Continuing, the German officer says the works constructed by the Greek engineers of Larissa are deserving of all praise, and fails to understand why they were abandoned. The Turkish army in the field, he further remarks, is one of the best that Turkey ever possessed, and says that no praise is too great for both the soldiers and officers. Bismarck Pasha gives his opinion of the self-sacrifice and enthusiasm animating the Turkish troops. In regard to the Greeks the German officer asserts that both officers and men were seized with panic, and a great number of Greeks in the face of the enemy stripped themselves of their uniforms, donned civilian clothes, and beseeched him to spare their lives.

In conclusion he says the Turks treated the prisoners and wounded with the greatest care.

Constantinople, May 7.—An official communication reiterates that the excesses attributed to the Turkish troops at Larissa are infamous calumnies and that the alleged Turkish evacuation of Thessaly is unfounded.

Athens, May 7.—A panic prevails at Larissa, on the Gulf of Lania, which is the new base of supplies for the Greek forces at Domokos. Many inhabitants are fleeing from the place, fearing to be attacked by the Turks. Turkish vessels are reported to have landed at Piraeus yesterday evening.

Athens, May 7.—A dispatch just received from Amoyos says that General Constandes has fled from there this morning, after having effected a retreat to Velestino in good order.

Larissa, May 7.—During yesterday the wounded Turkish soldiers were brought here from the front. The British report of the capture of Velestino by the Turks, where fighting has been severe in Volo, which is expected to be in the hands of the Turkish troops. Everybody speaks of the remarkable courage displayed by the Athenian troops.

Constantinople, May 7.—The proposed mediation of the powers between Turkey and Greece is viewed with favor by the Turkish government.

Another batch of men who had been sent with participating in the massacre of Armenians in the streets of Constantinople, have been sentenced to imprisonment. They have been condemned to four months or three to ten years imprisonment.

The authorities at Elezroum have been ordered to hold eleven regular regiments of the famous Hamazou cavalry corps in Thessaly. A battalion of 1,000 men has been sent to the island of Lemnos as a precaution against the landing of Greeks there.

The Turkish government last night received the following official dispatch from Pharsalos: "At dawn the Imperial troops, having attacked the enemy, occupied Pharsalos from which place a number of Greek troops had already fled, and retreated during the night. We defeated them and captured the town. Divisions of cavalry pursued the enemy to the road to Domokos, and the division under Khairi Pasha has been ordered to advance in that direction. The

Greeks left ammunition and provisions at Pharsalos.

Headquarters of the Turkish army, Thessaly, Pharsalos, May 7.—The Greeks are retreating across the plain towards the town. They have suffered terrible loss from the terrible fire of the Turkish artillery. During the retreat the Turks had to cross the river by a single bridge. As the Greek troops massed at that point, the Turkish artillery, getting exact range, wrought fearful havoc among the enemy; nevertheless, the Greeks fought desperately until nightfall.

London, May 7.—Advices from Athens say that a telegram has been received from Prince Constantine saying: "Our new position at Domokos is one of great strength. We are resolved to hold it at all costs. The retreat from Pharsalos was rendered imperative by the overwhelming numbers of the enemy, and was effected without mishap."

Headquarters of the Turkish army in Thessaly, Pharsalos, May 7.—Eight surrounding villages have also been occupied by the Turks, who captured a mountain battery, eighteen mules and a great quantity of ammunition and provisions, and the personal effects of the Greek prince, Prince Constantine and Prince Nicholas.

Washington, D. C., May 7.—Minister Terrel, at Constantinople, under date of yesterday, cables the state department that a telegram had been received from Edhem Pasha stating that he captured Pharsalos yesterday morning, and was pursuing the Greek army to Domokos. The mountain passes below Domokos could be easily defended, but it is reported that the Greek army is greatly demoralized and will offer but slight resistance to the advance of the Turkish troops.

**BUFFALO WILL CELEBRATE.**  
Loyal Subjects in America Will Do Honor to Queen Victoria.

Buffalo, N. Y., May 7.—A committee is busily engaged arranging for a banquet to be given in this city on June 22nd, in commemoration of the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Victoria. The banquet will be attended by the representative men of Buffalo. In consequence of the expressed desire on the part of a number of American Buffalo citizens, the banquet will be in no way restrained. The committee having the affair in charge are Messrs. George F. Moore, Wm. Staniland, T. Stewart, R. Langford, Robert Palen and Albert E. Jones. Arnold D. Rolph is acting secretary.

**QUITE A DIFFERENCE.**  
Between the Cost of Producing Lumber in United States and Canada.

Washington, D. C., May 7.—Comparing with a resolution of the senate, the commissioner of labor has sent the senate a statement showing the difference between the cost of producing white pine lumber in the United States and Canada. The report shows that while the average wages at sawmills in the United States are \$1.71 per day, and in Canada \$1.41, the average labor cost of 1,000 feet of lumber is \$10. In this country it is \$12.23 in Canada. This discrepancy is due to the fact that the superior machinery used in this country enables each laborer to accomplish more than in Canada.

**DEPARTMENTAL STORES.**  
Wholesale Firms and Grocers Agree to Boycott Them.

Montreal, May 7.—At a meeting of the Grocers' Association last night, it was announced that sixty-four wholesale firms and manufacturers had undertaken to protect the grocers against the departmental stores by pledging themselves not to sell either directly or indirectly to departmental stores in Montreal. Seven houses have refused to concur in this arrangement.

**THE TRANSVAAL RAID.**  
President of the Chartered Company Under Examination.

London, May 7.—The South African committee of the house of commons, which is inquiring into the Transvaal raids, had another session to-day in the committee room of Westminster Hall. The Duke of Abercorn, president of the Chartered Company of British South Africa, was examined. He said the board of directors of the company had no knowledge whatever of the raid before it occurred, nor any suspicion of any intention upon the part of any one to use the company's forces against the Transvaal.

**FIVE YEARS' IMPRISONMENT.**  
A Canadian Criminal in Trouble in London.

London, May 7.—Thomas Wood was sentenced in the Central criminal court to-day to five years' penal servitude for fraudulent advertising of loans. Wood, as shown at the trial, had previously served ten years' penal servitude in Canada.

## LOOK TO THE MOTHERLAND

**Canada Should Not Waste Time in Trade Negotiations With the United States.**

**Introduction of a Bill Incorporating Victoria, Vancouver and Eastern Railway.**

**Indian Agent at Kamloops Dismissed From Accompanying Assistant to London.**

Toronto, May 7.—The Globe, discussing the rejection of a arbitration treaty, draws attention to the Diebold bill's lumber provisions, and says: "The administration at Ottawa believe in the virtue of free trade, and as a big instalment of it the government was ready to negotiate reciprocity with the United States present masters at Washington. However, they will have none of it, and we must even let them rest in that frame of mind. Having in every honorable way sought to reach a fair settlement of relations between the two countries, and finding our neighbors in no mood even to negotiate, our better course is not to waste further energies in that direction. We have some great national problems to occupy us, and in the solution of some of our trade relations with the United States we are a factor. We can now proceed with consideration of these questions, as if this factor were eliminated. We must look more and more across the ocean for our customers. A good beginning has already been made in the lowered schedule for British goods, and the determination to finish the deepening of the canals at the earliest possible date. Mr. Fisher has completed his cold storage arrangements. The Premier's estimate seems in a fair way to be realized."

Ottawa, May 7.—Mr. Maxwell has introduced a bill to incorporate the Vancouver, Victoria & Eastern Railway Company. It was read a first time. Wentworth W. Wood has been dismissed from the position of Indian agent at Kamloops on account of political partisanship, and J. B. Leighton appointed in his stead.

Frederic Greenway, of Manitoba, is here en route to New York, where he goes to close an agreement with New York capitalists for the building of an air line from Winnipeg to Duluth. The lumber industry in Canada is guaranteed by the Manitoba government of interest on the bonds, the principal condition being that the rates from Lake Superior to Manitoba points will be reduced to the rate of the Great Lakes. **BURYING THE VICTIMS.**  
Twenty Funerals in Paris To-Day—Deep Sympathy Shown.

Paris, May 7.—Twenty victims of the fire on Tuesday last at the charity bazaar in the Rue Jean Goujon were buried to-day. The church, where the funeral services took place and the cortege traversed by the corteges were thronged with people. The crowd displayed the deepest sympathy for the relatives of the victims.

**BY-ELECTION IN CHILLIWACK.**  
A. S. Vedder, the Opposition Candidate, is Victorious.

Chilliwack, May 7.—The by-election in the district of Chilliwack necessitated by the death of Mr. T. E. Kitchen, resulted in the election of Mr. A. S. Vedder, the opposition candidate, as the successor of the late member of the local house. Chilliwack's municipality proper gave Mr. T. C. Higginson a majority of 9, but in the entire district Mr. Vedder secured a total of 37 votes more than his rival. Mr. Vedder is a prosperous farmer of Chilliwack, and has resided in that section for a great many years. At the last general election the late member received 325 votes, while S. A. Cawley, the government candidate, received 308.

## MARPOLE'S APPOINTMENT

That of Superintendent of Western Division of C. P. R.

Montreal, May 7.—The changes in the C.P.R. announced yesterday will not affect the divisions of the road as at present understood, so far as supervision of the sections by a general superintendent is concerned; and in this connection Mr. Marpole, formerly assistant under the late superintendent, Mr. Abbott, has been appointed general superintendent of the Pacific Coast division, and for the time being the position of general superintendent of the Western division will be fulfilled by Mr. Whyte in addition to his duties as manager of the lines. It is probable, however, that an appointment to this latter position will be made in the near future.

A TENNESSEE AIR SHIP.  
Moves in Perfect Order and is Pronounced a Success.

Nashville, Tenn., May 6.—To-day at the Centennial Exposition grounds Prof. Arthur Barnard, physical instructor of the Y.M.C.A. of Nashville, began a journey in an airship constructed by himself. The officials of the exposition and the people attending the exposition witnessed the ascent of the aerial voyager. The ship moved off in perfect order and passed out of sight in a few minutes. Prof. Barnard promised to resist the wind after arising into the air, and he did so. The air ship will be continued in use at the exposition. The air ship is 46 feet long and 20 feet in diameter. Mr. Barnard, who returned with his air ship to-night, says that he has a machine that will fly under ordinary conditions. He said to-night that it was not perfect, nor could it be perfectly controlled, but he believed he could perfect it so that its course could be controlled. After disappearing from view this morning the ship circled around, the navigator hoping to meet with a favorable current. At last the ship began to sail to the west and went on for some distance. The air ship is a village 15 miles west of the city, when it turned, and when four miles from Nashville, the gas in the balloon attached began to give out. He then sought a safe place to descend and came down safely. While aloft a sudden gust broke one of the spars of the ship. No other damage was done. The time he was aloft was one and a half hours. He was returning along the line of the outward flight when he was compelled to land.

**A GREAT INCREASE.**  
In the Number of Settlers From Western Ontario Leaving Toronto.

Toronto, May 7.—The total number of settlers from Western Ontario leaving this city on the nine spring excursions from Larissa, May 2nd to April 27th, was 2,308, about double the number of last year.
