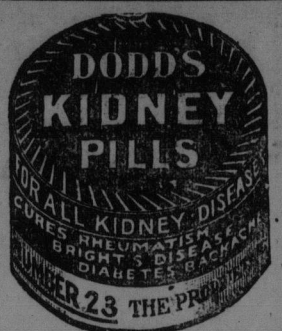

## GIFT AND ADDRESS

### FOR RETIRING PASTOR

Rev. Samuel J. Perry Suitably

Remembered on Eve of De-

parture from Lutes Moun-

tain Pastorate.

Lutes Mountain, Nov. 5.—A number of the Baptists, Reformed Baptists and Methodists of Lutes Mountain and vicinity met at the Baptist parsonage on the 4th inst. and presented the retiring pastor, Rev. You have developed in your sphere of activity a strong influence of interest, denominational fidelity among all Christian bodies, so that we, whether United Baptists, Methodists, Reformed Baptists, etc., feel that we will sustain a great loss in Christian fellowship by your removal from amongst us.

Dear Sister Perry.—We have appreciated in the fullest sense your efforts on our behalf, and your social tasks and strong Christian character, dear sister and brother, we bid you Godspeed in your departure, and we humbly pray that the great head of the church may abundantly bless you.

Mr. Perry replied in behalf of himself and family, thanking them for this very tangible expression of love as well as the kindness and good will showing them during his pastorate here. Speeches were made by Deacon Oliver Trites and Mr. McCutcheon, after which the Hymn Blest be the Tie that Binds, was sung, and Mr. Carpenter led in prayer. Cake and coffee was served by the ladies, and a very enjoyable time was spent. Mr. Perry goes to the North River field.

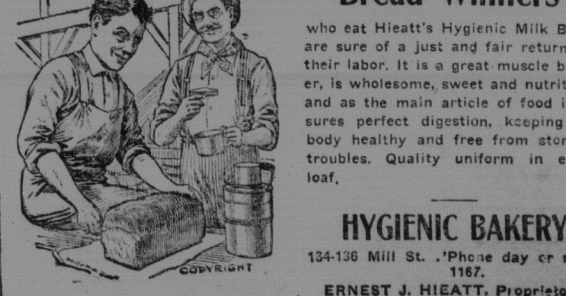
