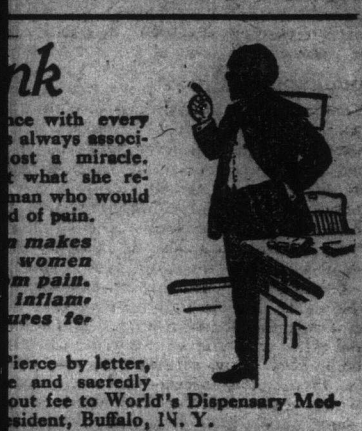

Halifax, Nov. 15.—Lieutenant Lord Alister Graham was today found guilty by court martial of causing or suffering to be caused the stranding of H. M. C. S. Niobe on July 30 last, on the dangerous ledge of Cape Sable. He was sentenced to be reprimanded.
