Systems Section, Fredericton Sub-Division General Investigation Section, Woodstock and Perth-Andover Detachments were also to participate.

The Force's primary assignment was to arrange security for the Thursday arrival of Mr. B. F. Stroganoff, President of Bluelandia, a fictitious, democratic eastern European country recently plagued with communist-led, insurgent activities, spearheaded by the BPPLA. Mr. Stroganoff and his Minister of Agriculture, Mr. I. M. Pomme de Terre, would be visiting the Town Hall, the

Royal Canadian Legion, the local Humpty Dumpty potato chip factory and a rural potato farm. Throughout the day we would also be responsible for traffic and crowd control, a VIP motorcade, road blocks and vehicle searches. Our secondary function was to gather local intelligence in an attempt to locate the terrorists' tactical command post (TCP), so that the military could attack and arrest the terrorists before they tried to assassinate Mr. Stroganoff.
